Legislative

NHRLA had a successful 2016 with early victories on predictive scheduling and the International Residential Code (IRC), as well as hosting a lobby day with more than 125 Senators and Representatives in attendance. In 2017, N.H. will have a new Governor, many new legislators serving in the General Court, and the beginning of a new legislative biennium, meaning New Hampshire will see a wide range of bills introduced. NHRLA will closely monitor the proposed legislation and prioritize any issues impacting its members in order to represent the lumber and building materials industry in Concord.

2016 Victories

NHRLA opposed SB 416, relative to flexible working arrangements, also known as the predictive scheduling bill. The legislation would have required employers to provide employees' schedules at least two weeks' in advance, and imposed penalties on employers for making changes to employees' schedules. NHRLA was successful in getting the Senate to drastically change the bill's language to allow employees to request a flexible schedule, but employers are not required to grant those requests.

Also, NHRLA worked closely with the New Hampshire Home Builders Association to address issues relative to the State Building Code. HB 1282 proposed updating the State's building code to the 2015 International Residential Code (IRC); however, the home builders and NHRLA had concerns with specific provisions in the 2015 IRC. Ultimately, the House killed the legislation due to the industry's concerns.

Grassroots Involvement/Relationship Building

NHRLA held a very successful legislative breakfast at the N.H. State House with more than 125 State Senators and Representatives in attendance. NHRLA is looking to build on its attendance for 2017, and encourages all NHRLA members to attend. NHRLA will continue to invite Senators and Representatives to speak at the NHRLA Board of Directors meetings. NHRLA also had Republican Gubernatorial Candidate Chris Sununu speak at one of their board of director meetings. NHRLA continues to find ways to build relationships with local legislators, and encourages NHRLA members to engage in legislative efforts.
