

~ WHO MAY APPLY & ELIGIBILITY ~

Applicants must be an employee, or a family member (child, step-child, grandchild, adopted child or spouse) of an employee, who works for a company that is a retail or associate member in good standing of the NHRLA, or an associate member of the NRLA who is a NHRLA sponsor.

1) NHRLA is offering up to nine (9) \$1,000 merit scholarships, NHRLA will consider awards in each of the following categories:

- Graduating high school senior attending college in the fall of 2021
- Matriculating college student entering sophomore, junior or senior year in the fall of 2021
- In the event that there are no qualifying entries for a participating category, NHRLA reserves the right to award multiple scholarships in one or more of the remaining categories for which there are additional qualified applicants

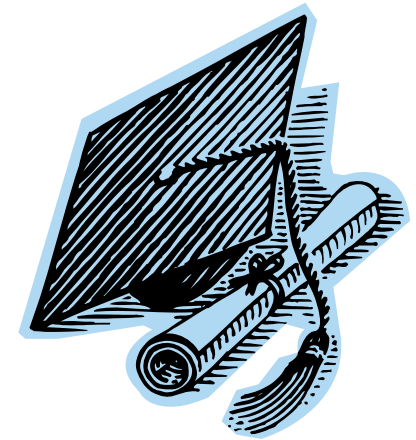

~ EVALUATION PROCESS ~

The NHRLA Scholarship Committee will review all applications. An important consideration for the Schuler Scholarship is financial need. Eligible candidates must submit their Expected Family Contribution (EFC) form calculated by completion of the FAFSA form in addition to the NHRLA Scholarship application. The recipients will be notified in June 2021.
